### Phonics

This is what we have been teaching in phonics this week.

We have learning the new phonemes above and revisiting all Phase 2 spellings.				We have learnt the trigraph ear and revisited the spelling all.	
Please check if your child can remember these graphemes and read these words.					

In **Maths** this week we have been learning how to double. The children have been doubling numbers up to 6 and recording this onto a template or whiteboards. The children have selected their own resources to work out the double: counters, fingers or drawing dots. To make links within their learning the children have been writing the doubled number as a number sentence e.g. double 4 is 8 or  $4 + 4 = 8$ .

### Homework - Phonics/Literacy

Please encourage your child to write about the character they dressed up as on World Book Day. Who were they? Why is this their favourite book character? Please do not write the sentence for your child to copy but provide scaffolded lines if needed.

If you attended the after school reading session on Tuesday, please comment in your child's contact book if you found this session helpful and what you took away with you.
