Dear Parents & Carers,

We have had a lovely end to our term. The children have worked really hard and I am sure everyone is looking forward to a well-deserved break. In English we have been writing a recount of our Forest School inspired learning. In Mathematics we have been consolidating our knowledge of time, fractions and scales. We also really enjoyed the colour run!

Reading: Please keep reading at home and encouraging your child to complete their quizzes at school. Remember to let us know about their home reading (any reading it doesn't have to be their school reading book) in their home contact books. The children are making really good progress with their reading and we are very grateful for all of the support you are providing at home. We have attached some reading comprehension practice that you might like to complete.

Spelling: Thank you for your support with last week's spellings. We have attached some common exception words for the children to practice over the holidays. The children are beginning to apply their spelling practice to their writing but there are still a few common exception words that they are getting wrong.

Writing: The children are making really good progress with their writing and their recounts this week have been amazing! We have attached some paper and a copy of our writing target pencil in case your child would like to do some writing over the holidays. They might like to keep a diary of all of the fun things they do over Easter. Please encourage them to look at the writing target pencil and see how many things they can tick off.

Maths: We have set some activities on Mathematics that you might like to do this week as well as the attached mathematics sheets.

Please remember we do not expect you to complete all of the suggested pieces of homework. Pick and choose what you would like to practice. As an added reward for learning at home every time you read or complete one page of homework you will receive 2 dojo points.

Forest School inspired learning: Thank you to everyone who has already brought in some forest school clothes. We have decided to do Forest School inspired activities every Friday next term so every child will need suitable clothing in school or they will not be able to take part.
